

## Summary of By-law Applications

### By-Law 5 – Dogs

Having reviewed the requirements under the Dog and Cat Management Act with the Manager of Planning and Regulatory Services, the following on-leash, off-leash and dog prohibited areas are proposed (See Attached Map):

Pursuant to the power contained in Section 246(3)(e) of the Local Government Act 1999, and for the purpose of Clause 9 and 10 of By-law No.5 (Dogs), the Council authorises:

1. Dog Free Areas:

- All ovals and sports arenas at times when there is organised sport or training or other community events in place;

2. Dog 'On-Leash' Areas:

Kingston

- All ovals and sports arenas at times when no organised sport or training or other community events are evident
- The foreshore south of the southern Kingston boat haven groyne and north of Pinks Beach entrance
- The Kingston jetty
- All roads, footpaths, walking and bicycle tracks within the township of Kingston
- All reserves and parks (except for the section of Maria Creek Reserve north of Maria Creek)
- Within 100 metres of a school or playground.

Cape Jaffa

- The foreshore and beach west of Cape Jaffa Anchorage breakwater groyne and east of the Rothalls Road at Cape Jaffa 1 December to 30 April
- The Cape Jaffa jetty
- All roads and footpaths within the township of Cape Jaffa
- All reserves and parks

3. Dog 'Off-Leash' Areas:

- Maria Creek Reserve north of Maria Creek
- The foreshore north of the northern Kingston boat haven groyne to the Coorong District Council
- The foreshore south of Pinks Beach entrance and east of Cape Jaffa Anchorage Eastern Groyne
- The beach west of the Rothalls Road to the Robe District Council boundary.
